

**2010 Legacies Now Society
Accessible Tourism Olympic Tickets Contest
Rules and Regulations**

Qualified Entry and Entrant

- Qualified entrants will be restricted to:
 - (a) An individual who has participated in a Tourism British Columbia WorldHost[®] Customers with Disabilities Training Workshop between June 2, 2009 and October 30, 2009
- 2010 Legacies Now will contact all Qualified Entrants and provide them with access to the Contest website.
- A Qualified Entrant can submit a Qualified Entry by completing the online entry form and submitting it to 2010 Legacies Now between June 2, 2009 and November 16, 2009.
- All Entrants must agree to provide 2010 Legacies Now with their contact information (organization, city, email address, phone number, postal code and name of contact person) in order to be entered into this Contest. Such information will be used exclusively for the purpose of allowing 2010 Legacies Now to conduct the draw and will not be shared or sold to any third party.
- To be declared the winner, the selected Entrant must first correctly answer, unaided, a time-limited, mathematical skill-testing question posed by telephone at a mutually convenient time; and will also need to return a signed acknowledgment form relating to compliance with contest conditions.
- 2010 Legacies Now rulings are final and without appeal in all matters related to the promotion and the awarding of the prize.
- One entry per Qualified Entrant will be eligible for the Contest.
- 2010 Legacies Now reserves the right to withdraw entries should duplicates or false information be found.

Contest Period and Contest Deadline

- The Contest Period runs June 2 2009 and November 16, 2009.
- The required entry form must be submitted online by the Contest Deadline, which is 11:59 pm PST on November 16, 2009. All portions of the entry form must be completed.

How to Enter

- No purchase necessary.
- Qualified Entrants will be notified by email by 2010 Legacies Now, after completion of the WorldHost[®] Customers with Disabilities Workshop, that they are qualified to enter this contest and receive website directions.
- Qualified Entrants can visit the contest website to fill out and submit online the prescribed entry form.
- 2010 Legacies Now is not responsible for lost, late, damaged, illegible, stolen, misdirected, misidentified, postage due or incomplete entries, for any problems or technical or mechanical malfunction of any telephone systems, computer on-line systems, servers, access providers, computer equipment, software, failure of any entry to be received by 2010 Legacies Now on

account of technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any website, or inaccurate entry information, whether caused by equipment, programming used in this Contest, human processing or otherwise, or any combination thereof.

- Written, video and photo entries become the property of 2010 Legacies Now and may be used for promotional purposes of 2010 Legacies Now relating to this contest or otherwise.

Random Draw

- Contact particulars of all qualified entrants who submit an entry will be compiled by 2010 Legacies Now for the purposes of conducting a random draw.
- A draw to select one (1) Winner from among the Qualified Entries will be made by an independent audit firm on behalf of 2010 Legacies Now on November 20, 2009 or as soon as practical thereafter from all qualifying entries received prior to the contest deadline.
- Upon the winning entry being drawn, the 2010 Legacies Now representative will certify and declare that the entrant assigned to that entry is the Winning Individual if such entry and entrant meets these Contest Conditions. If not, another entry shall be selected. An entry or entrant not meeting these Contest Conditions shall be disqualified. Any disqualified entry or entrant cannot win a prize.
- The Winning Individual wins one (1) prize.

Prize

- The prize is:
 - Two tickets to the Freestyle Skiing Men's Aerials Final at the 2010 Olympic Winter Games.

Travel arrangements will not be made by 2010 Legacies Now and will be the responsibility of the Winning Individual and their guest. The Freestyle Skiing Men's Aerials Final tickets are valued at \$300 and can not be resold or transferred to another organization or person.

Possession and use of the tickets is subject to the terms and conditions established by the Games organizers. The approximate value of the prize is \$300.

- The Winning Individual may not auction, raffle, sell, transfer, barter or exchange this prize or any portion in any manner whatsoever.

 - (a) Directors and employees (and their family members) of 2010 Legacies Now and the Vancouver Organizing Committee for the 2010 Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games (VANOC);

 - (c) Individuals elected to public office.

conditions prescribed to such tickets from time to time by the Vancouver Organizing Committee for the 2010 Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games (VANOC).
